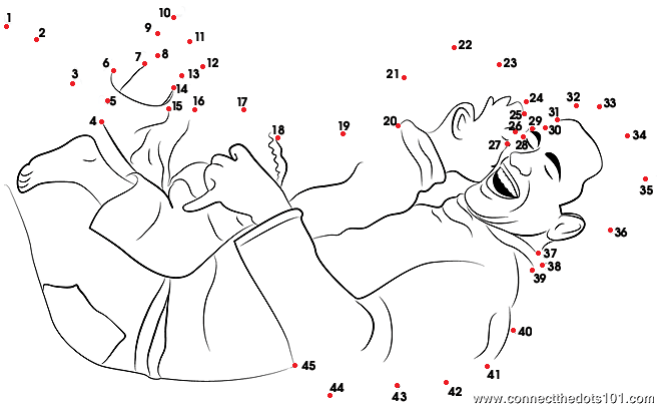


Don't let drugs cause things in your life to go wrong. Say "NO!" to drugs.

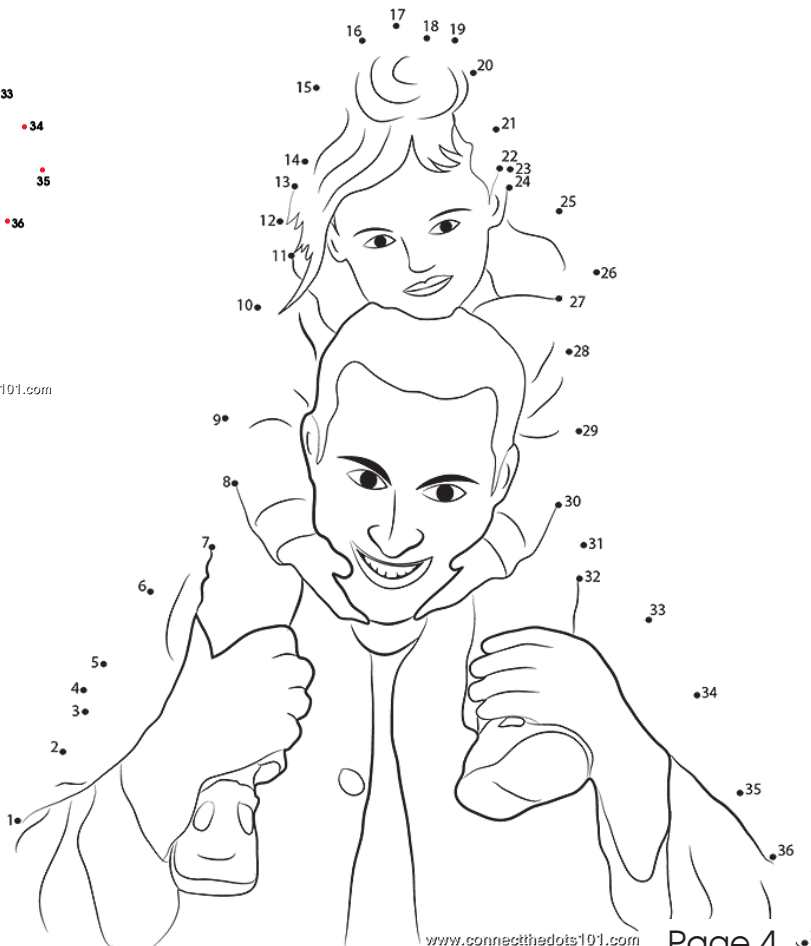
Colour the picture on the left and put a cross on the 8 things that are wrong in the picture.
